

## FAILURE TO SUBMIT MINORITY SLATES FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE BOARD OF STATUTORY AUDITORS; EXTENSION OF THE DEADLINE AND HALVING OF THE SHAREHOLDING THRESHOLDS FOR FILING

**Arco (TN), March 30, 2024** – With reference to the Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting convened for 23 April 2024, Aquafil S.p.A. hereby announces that within the terms set forth in the notice of call for the submission of lists for the renewal of the Company's corporate bodies, as of yesterday's date, only one list was submitted for the appointment of the Board of Statutory Auditors by the majority shareholder Aquafin Holding S.p.A. Therefore, pursuant to art. 144-sexies, paragraph 5, of the Consob Issuers' Regulation no. 11971/1999, the deadline for the submission of minority lists for the aforementioned appointment of the members of the Board of Statutory Auditors is extended by a further three days (i.e. until 1 April 2023), and the shareholding threshold provided for by the Articles of Association is reduced to half, and is therefore equal to 1.25% of the share capital.

The lists for the appointment of the Board of Statutory Auditors, signed by the Shareholder(s) submitting them, must be deposited at the Company's registered office, or alternatively by e-mail sent to the certified e-mail address <u>pec.aquafil@aquafil.legalmail.it</u>, together with the documentation required by law and the Articles of Association, under penalty of forfeiture.
