

Privacy Policy - Webinar

Who are we and what do we do with your personal data?

Aquafil S.p.A., hereafter, Data Controller, protects the confidentiality of your personal data and guarantees the safeguarding required by each event that may place them at risk of violation.

To that end, the Data Controller implements policies and practices concerning the collection and use of personal data and the exercise of the rights granted to you by the applicable regulations. The Data Controller updates its policies and practices on personal data protection every time this is necessary or when regulatory and organisational changes are made that may affect the processing of your personal data.

How does Data Controller collect and process your data?

Data Controller processes your personal data, such as:

- name, surname,
- physical and electronic address
- images
- relating to commercial and/or professional activity.

Your personal information will be processed for:

1) the management of the event (webinar)

The processing of your personal data takes place to carry out the preliminary and consequent activities to the management of your relationship with the Data Controller and those instrumental and functional to its performance, as well as for the fulfillment of any other obligation deriving from it.

The obligations that the Data Controller must fulfill depending on the contract and specific regulations that govern it are those of:

- the keeping of the accounts;
- monitoring/updating of service conditions.

Your personal data is also collected from third parties such as:

- IT service provider

2) communication to third parties and recipients

Your personal data is processed under the contract and the legal and regulatory obligations resulting from it.

Your data will not be disclosed to third parties/recipients for their own purposes unless:

- 1) you authorise to do so;
- 2) it is necessary for the fulfilment of obligations under the contract and law regulations governing it (e.g. for the defence of your rights, for reporting to the supervisory authorities, etc.);
- 3) the communication is made to: the companies of the Group to which the Data Controller belongs, providers of IT assistance services, third-party IT supply and assistance and data processing companies (e.g. web hosting, data entry, management and maintenance of IT infrastructures and services, etc.).

3) Marketing activity

If you sign up for the newsletter, the processing of your personal data takes place to offer you products and services of the Data Controller, or even improved or more suited to your needs and, finally, to send you information and advertising material.

The sending of informative/promotional material, through the use of your data (such as name, surname, e-mail address) can take place to:

- e-mail

The processing in question takes place if you give your consent for the use of the data also with reference to the communication methods, both traditional and automated, with which the processing takes place. You can always revoke your consent by stopping the processing.

4) IT security activities related to the prevention of data breaches

Purpose	Legal basis
- implementation of procedures for detecting and notifying personal data breaches (data breach)	Compliance with legal obligations (detection and notification of data breach events)

What happens if you do not provide your data?

If you do not provide your personal data, the Data Controller will not be able to carry out the processing operations related to the management of the contract and its services or the obligations that depend on it.

The intention of the Data Controller was to carry out certain processing operations in accordance with certain legitimate interests that do not affect your right to confidentiality, such as those that:

- prevent IT accidents and allow notification to the supervisory authority or communication to users, if necessary, of the personal data breach;
- allow communication to third parties/recipients for activities related to those of contract management.

What happens if you do not give your consent to the processing of personal data for marketing purposes?

The processing of your personal data will not take place for these purposes; this will not have any effect on the processing of your data for the main purposes, nor for that for which you have already given your consent, if requested.

If you have given authorization and were to subsequently revoke it or object to the processing, your data will no longer be processed for such marketing activities, without this leading to consequences or prejudicial effects

How, where and for how long will your data be stored?

How

Data relating to you is processed using both electronic and manual tools and instruments made available to persons acting under the authority of the Data Controller and for authorised and trained purposes. The paper and, above all, electronic archives in which your data are archived and stored are protected using effective security measures adequate to combat the risks of violation considered by the Data Controller.

Where

The data is retained on paper, computer and electronic files located within the European Economic Area, and appropriate security measures are ensured.

The personal data collected through the webinar streaming platform may be transferred outside the European Economic Area and the following guarantees are ensured pursuant to articles. 45 et seq GDPR:

- standard contractual clauses.

How long

The personal data processed by the Data Controller is retained for the time necessary for the carrying-out of activities related to the management of the contract with the Data Controller and until ten years after its conclusion (art. 2946 of the Italian Civil Code) or from when the rights that depend on it can be enforced (pursuant to art. 2935 of the Italian Civil Code); as well as for the fulfilment of the obligations (e.g. tax and accounting obligations) that remain even after the conclusion of the contract (art. 2220 of the Italian Civil Code), for the purposes of which the Data Controller must retain only the data necessary for their furtherance. This is without prejudice to the cases in which the rights deriving from the contract should be asserted in court, in which case your data, only that necessary for these purposes, will be processed for the time necessary to pursue them.

The IT data (logical and navigation accesses) are kept for the time necessary to guarantee checks on the security of the systems, except in cases where events occur that require the intervention of the competent authorities, also in collaboration with third parties/ recipients who are responsible for the IT security activity of the Data Controller's data, to carry out any investigations into the causes that led to the event.

Personal data processed for marketing purposes will be retained by the Company for two years starting from the provision of consent, unless the consent you have given is revoked and/or you object to the processing.

This is without prejudice to your right to oppose at any time the processing based on legitimate interest for reasons related to your particular situation.

What are your rights?

In line with the time limits established above for the processing of personal data relating to you, the rights that are granted to you allow you always to have control of your data. Your rights are those of:

- access;
- rectification;
- erasure;
- restriction on processing;
- opposition to processing;
- portability.

Your rights are granted to you without particular burdens and formalities in relation to the request to exercise them which is essentially understood to be free of charge. You have the right:

- o to obtain a copy, even in electronic format, of the data that you have asked to access. If you request further copies, the Data Controller may charge to you a reasonable contribution to costs;
- o to obtain the erasure of the same or the restriction of processing or even the update or rectification of your personal data and to guarantee that third parties/recipients, who have received your data, also adjust to your request, unless legitimate reasons prevail over those that determined your request (e.g. environmental surveys and containment of risk determined by the emergency managed through them by the Controller);
- o to obtain any useful communication in relation to the activities performed following the exercise of your rights without delay and in any case within one month from your request, subject to motivated extension of up to two months, which must be duly communicated to you.
- o For any further communication and in any case to submit your request, you must contact the Controller, at the address privacy@aquafil.com

How and when can you object to the processing of your personal data?

For reasons relating to your particular situation, you may object at any time to the processing of your personal data if it occurs for marketing purposes (direct, market research and surveys), by sending your request to the Controller at the address privacy@aquafil.com

You are entitled to the erasure of your personal data if you have objected to the processing for marketing purposes (direct, market research and surveys).

With whom may I lodge a complaint?

Subject to any other action in the administrative or judicial venue, you may lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority or with that which performs its duties and exercises its powers in Italy where you have your habitual residence or where you work or, if different, in the Member State in which the violation of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 occurred.

Any update to this privacy policy will be communicated to you promptly and by appropriate methods and you will also be notified if the Data Controller is to process your data for purposes additional to those indicated in this privacy policy before it proceeds to do so and in time for your to provide your consent, if required.
